

HAY COMMUNICATIONS 2010 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To demonstrate dedication and commitment to education and to rural youth, Hay Communications offers two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each to students who are currently enrolled full time at College, University or Vocational Institute of higher learning.

The determination of the winning applicants will be based on community involvement, extra-curricular school involvement, academic achievement and general quality of the application.

Applications for the 2010 Scholarships will become available in September 2010 and will be posted on the website. Hay Communications encourages all students who qualify to apply.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. The applicant is enrolled full time in the second, third or fourth year of a program at a Canadian post secondary institution and has not previously received a scholarship from Hay Communications.
2. The applicant agrees to allow Hay Communications to publicize their name and photo in the event they are chosen as a recipient of the scholarship.
3. The applicant or the Parent/Guardian of the applicant must have active phone service in the 236, 237 or 238 exchanges and be a member of Hay Communications Co-operative Limited.
4. Children of employees or directors of Hay Communications are not eligible.

Application process:

The applicant must submit the completed application form and supporting documentation to the business office of Hay Communications **by October 29, 2010.**

Required supporting documentation includes proof of enrollment for the current academic year and academic transcript for the previous academic year.
